
NEW Energy Labels Explained



With energy efficiency becoming increasingly more important, so is the demand for appliances to become more eco friendly.

The new energy label was launched in **November 2020** with the aim of making the labels easier to understand with more opportunity for manufactures to build more energy efficient appliances without adding more '+'s.

What is different?

Appliances rated A+++ on the old scale are now rated at around D on the new scale. The efficiency hasn't changed, the labelling has.

The NEW Label...

- 1 The appliances energy efficiency class.
- \bigcirc The new scale is A G (replacing A+++ D).
- **3** QR code.
- Weighted energy consumption per 100 cycles.
- 5 Rated capacity on a 'ECO 40-60' programme.
- 6 Duration of the 'ECO 40-60' programme.
- Weighted water consumption per cycle.
- 8 Spin-drying efficiency class.
- Airbourne acoustical noise emissions & class.
